We value your membership and look forward to your renewed participation. Please remember if your dues are not paid by December 31<sup>st</sup>, you may not participate in Zone sports.


Please put your money or cheque payable to the auxiliary in an envelope in the auxiliary mailbox at the branch. Please include a stamped return envelope to receive your new card.




